

WHEREAS, the PCS-AHMOPI MOA took effect on January 1, 2019 and shall expire on December 31, 2021, after which period both parties may jointly review, revise and/or modify the said MOA, if necessary, prior to its renewal for another three (3)-year term.


WHEREAS, AHMOPI Members and PCS Members (hereinafter referred to as the "Physician", and is duly licensed to practice medicine in the Philippines) are desirous of entering into an arrangement whereby PCS Physicians will provide medical services to AHMOPI plan holders in different localities/communities all over the Philippines .

WHEREAS, all AHMOPI members who have consented in writing to the PCS-AHMOPI MOA & IRR cannot refuse PCS physicians who have voluntarily agreed to join MOA initiatives and have an enforce Unified Service Agreement (USA) issued by the AHMOPI, even if these physicians are outside of the AHMOPI-Member's network of accredited physicians, except for just cause as provided for in the PCS or PMA Code of Ethics and as determined by the PCS-AHMOPI Liaison Committee. In like manner, PCS physicians who have voluntarily consented in writing to the PCS-AHMOPI MOA and IRR cannot refuse AHMOPI patients once they are chosen except for just cause as provided for in the PCS or PMA Code of Ethics and as determined by the PCS-AHMOPI Liaison Committee.

1. The Physician agrees to render quality and cost-effective medical services to patients of AHMOPI members. In consideration for the above services, the following professional fees (exclusive of Philippine Health Insurance Corporation fees) will be paid:

1.1. Out-patient consultation fees:

The Parties agree that the outpatient consultation fee of the Specialist shall be Four Hundred Pesos (Php 400.00) regardless of their place of practice. Please see Annex "A" for the Philippine Academy of Ophthalmology (PAO) and Annex "B" for the Philippine Society of Otolaryngology - Head and Neck Surgery (PSO-NHS).

1.2. All professional surgical fees shall be based on the current/prevaling Philippine Health Insurance Corp. (PHIC) Relative Value Scale (RVS).



Compensation for subsequent daily visits for confinements for complications that may occur after surgery, for the same or new condition/s which may not be related to the initial surgery shall be the same as provided in 1.3. above.



For voluntary room upgrades as defined above, PCS doctors may bill AHMOPI member-patients for the difference in professional fees (PF) between the member-patient's original room category and the upgraded room used, based on the PF schedules of the PCS-AHMOPI MOA which are currently applicable within the contract period of his Service Agreement with the AHMOPI-member concerned.

- 1.7.3. The same PF schedules of Items 1.1, 1.2 & 1.3 above should likewise be used for AHMOPI member-patients who exceed their Maximum Benefit Limits (MBL) per illness or injury per year or Aggregate Benefit Limit (ABL) per year under their respective Agreements.

The Physician shall not "balance-bill" AHMOPI patients for coverable health conditions and treatments, nor enter into any private fee arrangements with AHMOPI patients, even with the latter's consent. However, for non-coverable

health conditions and availments, the Physician may bill AHMOPI patients for Professional Fees based on the PF schedules of the AHMOPI Member concerned.

The Physician and AHMOPI agree that the consultation and surgical professional fees (Items 1.1, 1.2 & 1.3 above) shall be exclusive of the PHIC payment. However, it is understood that if the AHMOPI member-patient is not a PhilHealth Member, the Physician cannot bill the AHMOPI member nor the AHMOPI patient for the PhilHealth portion of the consult/surgical fees.


All PFs are subject to the prevailing withholding tax rates and such other tax provisions. The prevailing Value Added Tax (VAT) currently at twelve percent (12%) shall be shouldered by the AHMOPI-Member concerned provided the Physician submits VAT registration certificates to the AHMOPI Member. On the other hand, withholding taxes will be deducted from the Physician's Professional Fees.

For medical procedures listed in the Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth) and Philippine College of Surgeons (PCS) handbook of 2001, as amended in 01 April 2009, AHMOPI Members agree to pay professional fees based on the current/prevaling PHIC Relative Value Scale (which is currently the 2009 RVS). For those procedures not listed, the PCS-AHMOPI Liaison Committee, in collaboration with the PCS Subspecialties concerned, shall meet and decide on the most appropriate PF schedules.

All bills pertinent to PFs of the Physician for out-patient services afforded plan holders of AHMOPI members must be submitted to the AHMOPI member concerned within forty-five (45) days (but not later than five (5) months from date of services, otherwise the same shall become null and non-payable) from date of service; and all in-patient claims must be submitted by the hospital within thirty (30) days to the AHMOPI member concerned. All bills presented by the Physician with complete documentation shall be fully paid by the AHMOPI member according to the negotiated rates (item 1 above) within forty-five (45) days from receipt of out-patient claims from the Physician, and within thirty (30) days from receipt of in-patient claims from the hospital.

The Physician shall extend utmost cooperation and shall coordinate with the AHMOPI Member on all matters pertaining to the effective and efficient delivery of health care and other support services.

9. The Physician shall comply with the policies and guidelines governing the servicing of Plan holders of AHMOPI Members such as, but not limited to, providing medical records, operative reports, discharge summaries, etc., whenever these shall be needed.
10. The Physician is an independent contractor, hence he/she is not considered an employee of the AHMOPI nor any of its Members. As such, the AHMOPI nor any of its Members shall not assume any statutory employer obligations such as, but not limited to, Social Security, PhilHealth, and Employee's Compensation premiums, etc.
11. The Physician agrees to hold AHMOPI Members and its plan holders free and harmless from any claim or liability to any third party arising out of, or related to, any act, omission or negligence of the part of the Physician.
12. This Agreement is effective from FEB 2, 2020 to December 31, 2021 unless earlier terminated/revoked by either party by giving a thirty (30)-day prior notice to the other party.
13. Any modification/s to this Agreement shall be embodied in an Addendum to be attached herein and considered an integral part hereof.
14. Any PCS Physician or AHMOPI member participating in the PCS-AHMOPI MOA found to have violated any provision of the same by the PCS-AHMOPI Liaison Committee may be removed from the roster of participating members of the PCS-AHMOPI MOA.

**Annex "C"**

**Multiple Surgeries**

- I. Multiple related surgical procedures performed during the same operative session involving the same or separate incision shall be compensated as follows:
  - 1.1. If done by the same surgeon:
    - 1.1.1. 100% of the RUV allowed for the primary procedure. (Primary procedure is considered to be the surgical procedure that has the highest RUV).
    - 1.1.2. 50% of the RUV allowed for the secondary procedure.
    - 1.1.3. 25% of the RUV allowed for the subsequent (tertiary, etc.) procedures, subject to evaluation.
  - 1.2. If done by another surgeon:
    - 1.2.1. 80% of the RUV allowed for the procedure.
- II. Multiple unrelated surgical procedures, done either by the same surgeon or another, involving same or separate incision performed during the same operative session, shall be compensated as:
  - 1.1. 100% of the RUV allowed for the primary procedures.
  - 1.2. 50% of the RUV allowed for secondary procedures.
  - 1.3. 25% of the RUV allowed for subsequent (tertiary, etc.) procedures, subject to evaluation.
