

PRESIDENT'S REPORT

The Re-Defining of the PCS

On September 12, 1936, two months before the formal induction into office of Manuel L. Quezon as President of the Commonwealth of the Philippines, the Philippine College of Surgeons was established. The organization's purpose was "to establish and maintain an organization of surgeons for the advancement of the Science and Art of Surgery, with the welfare of the patient in mind, and to promote the ethical and competent practice of specialty (*PCS Articles of Incorporation, 1946*)". The PCS attracted members based on the reputation of its founders (*Eight Decades of Philippine Surgery, 2016*).

In May of this year, a new Mission and Vision of the College was launched. This was ratified during the Business Meeting at the 49th Midyear Convention in Davao.

Vision

We are the premier organization of surgical professionals.

Mission

We shall fulfill our vision through Quality Surgery for all.

The College continues to expand the Fellows' professional development through the Midyear Convention and the Annual Clinical Congress. The Subcommittee on Surgical Information Communication and Technology has launched an online learning platform that is now available to residents. And in addition to this, webinars are being offered in finance and financial well-being for fellows. The Philippine Journal of Surgical Specialties is currently indexed in the Western Pacific Rim Index Medicus. It also has begun registering its content through DOI or the digital objective identifiers for quick and easy access of articles on the internet. Through the hard-working PCS Secretariat and the enthusiastic members of the various committees, programs and projects of the PCS are being fulfilled. These are just examples of recent developments in the college.

And while the PCS continues to remain faithful to its original goals, it is, however, broadening its goals. National programs on Trauma, Cancer, Outreach Programs and Infection Control were established (*PCS By-Laws, 1984*). We have seen this develop into the creation of commissions intended to act as "external arms of the College, primarily concerned with PCS flagship programs directed to specific areas of national concern (*PCS Administrative Manual 2019*)". Currently, the College has the Trauma, Injury and Burn Care Commission, Cancer Commission and S.U.R.E. Commission. The TIBCC has a strong foothold on disaster prevention. The Cancer Commission is closely working with government agencies to see the full implementation of RA 11215 or the National Integrated Cancer Control Act passed in February 2019. And the SURE Commission has covered many of the Geographically Isolated Disadvantaged barangays and the underserved areas. It has provided much needed surgeries, together with educating local surgeons. We are looking forward to collaborating with foreign surgical associations and colleges.

With the passing of RA 11223 or the Universal Health Care Law, the AdHoc Committee on UHC is now a standing committee. Currently, a study is being conducted to determine the true and reasonable cost

of surgery. Results shall be collated and shall be submitted to the concerned agencies to fine tune the IRR of the UHC law.

It would be so easy to just enumerate the functions and accomplishments of the 53 committees and subcommittees of the PCS, together with the activities of the different chapters and the specialty and affiliate societies. But it would not paint a complete picture of what the PCS is. Through the efforts of the past Boards of Regents, the college has slowly involved itself in matters outside the confines of the operating room. The PCS has boldly taken an active role in the activities of the Department of Health, the Professional Regulation Commission, the Philippine Health Insurance Corporation, other government and non-government agencies and even Congress. We now wear a new coat and are comfortable in it!

We remain true to the original purpose by which the PCS was created "for the advancement of the Science and Art of Surgery, with the welfare of the patient in mind, and to promote the ethical and competent practice of specialty ". The PCS is more than an organization providing Continuous Professional Development opportunities, providing surgical missions and all the things listed above. It has immersed itself in the processes that shape policies and health initiatives that influence and control surgical practice, as it continues its mission of Quality Surgery for All.

This Annual Report serves as the record of the year 2023. I thank all of you who have continuously and tirelessly worked for the College. May all Fellows have that sense of belonging to the Philippine College of Surgeons and share the vision and mission of the College.














6. Guidelines for applying PRC-CPD Units

The organization or society submits the proposal to include the following:

- a. CPDD-02 Application form for Accreditation of CPD program. This includes
 - Program title
 - Date to be offered or proposed webinar
 - Venue and address/platform
 - Target participants
 - Registration fee
 - Course Description, Objectives, etc.

PRC requirements/checklists:

- CPDD16 form Instructional Design as prescribed by the relevant Board.
- Program of Activities showing time/duration of topics/workshop and resource persons with position and office, and evaluation period.

- Evaluation method or tool that measures the learning gained by the participants specific and appropriate to course objectives set
- Post-Test Questions
- CPDD17 form Resume of resource persons relevant to CPD program applied for.
- Photocopy of valid Professional Identification Card of resource persons if registered professional. Otherwise, submit photocopy of government-issued or company Identification Card.
- Valid Special Temporary Permit if the resource person is a foreigner and if engagement is more than three (3) days or there is physical contact with patients in the case of medical and allied professions.
- Breakdown of expenses for the conduct of the CPD program.
- For Online Learning, Declaration of Minimum Technical Requirements (e.g. Operating System, Processor, Memory, Browser, Internet Connection, etc.)
- Other relevant documents: Poster, data privacy act and Certificate of Attendance

The above requirements must be submitted **sixty (60) days prior to target schedule for PRC-CPD accreditation**, to allow time for processing.

- b. If the assessment is favorable, pay prescribed fee of One Thousand Pesos († 1,000.00) per program offering. Government agencies and instrumentalities offering CPD Programs free of charge, do not have to pay a fee.
- C. CPDD-05 Form Completion Report

The Completion Report must be submitted within 30 calendar days after the CPD program offering and must include the Monitor's Report.

Checklist of Requirements:

- Hard and electronic copies of registration and/or attendance sheets (preferably in excel format). Registration Sheets must show the name of participants and guests, PRC License Number (if applicable), contact details and signature while the attendance sheet shall include the name of participants, license numbers, expiry date and signature
- Actual program of activities with the list and profile of lecturers/resource persons and information about any deviation from the approved program.
- Lecture materials
- Summary of evaluation of resource persons in tabular form
- Summary of evaluation of learning of the participants
- Financial Report
- Relevant photographs
- Souvenir magazine, if available
- d. Attended PRC Dialogues with CPD Providers with the following updates relayed to PCS:
 - Application for program accreditation is now 30 working days (from 15 working days) prior to program offering.
 - Payment for processing is within 3 working days if done through the PRC cashier or immediately upon submission if thru online payment.
 - Submission of completion reports is now 15 working days after the end of the program.
 - Application for renewal of accreditation as CPD provider is within 90 days from expiration.
 - For hybrid programs, separate applications (for online and face to face) should be submitted.

- For applied programs with no definite response within 10 days after submission, we can assume that it has already been approved.
- PRC should be informed of changes in the program within 5 days prior to the start of the event.
- The requirements for online and face to face programs are now the same.

Colostomy Freedom Project



The Colostomy Freedom Project, which intends to deliver free professional medical and surgical services to indigent pediatric patients suffering from anorectal malformations and Hirschsprung's disease, was launched this year, with its first mission in Iloilo City last February 9-12, 2023. The project aims to help these

children grow without the social stigma brought about the need for colostomy.

Pediatric Surgical Mission with World Surgical Foundation Philippines

On February 9-12, 2023, the World Surgical Foundation Philippines partnered with PSPS along with the Philippine Pediatric Society (PPS), Philippine Society of Anesthesiologists (PSA) and other government and non-government collaborators for its first surgical mission in Iloilo City. Through this activity, children born with anorectal malformation and Hirschsprung disease who are living with colostomies were given hope towards better, brighter, colostomy-free future.

The session entitled *Brain Tumor Service Delivery In Children: Addressing the Barriers and Challenges Through Collaboration*, aimed to address the different issues in the screening, diagnosis, and treatment of brain tumors in children. 
PSCRS - PSPS Combined Colorectal Meeting



A Pediatric Colorectal Surgeon from the Medical University of Vienna, Austria, Dr. Carlos Albert Reck-Burneo, then gave a lecture on Innovations in the Management of Anorectal Malformations, which included new technology and techniques recently being applied to pediatric surgical care.

Dr. Arden Asuncion, a fifth year General Surgery resident, then proceeded to present a case discussion on the Multidisciplinary Management of Pediatric Trauma Patients. This led to a discussion on the current protocols for managing pediatric trauma patients, and placed an emphasis on the need to call for help from different subspecialty services early on.

After a fruitful discussion, the program ended with closing remarks delivered by PSPS President Dr. Bong Tuazon.
